Dixie is working with Simply Hope on the catering. Thanks Dixie!"</p> <p>Brittany Shipley discussed HB236, which passed on the floor yesterday. This bill aims to remove children with felony charges-such as aggravated assault-from the education system. It mandates that parents inform school of their child's criminal record and excludes children from school settings if they have a history of assaults or batteries, without consideration for the context of the incidents, including development or mental health issues. A significant concern is that many of these charges are against very young children, some under the age of 12. The bill is now moving on to the next legislative stage, with plans for it to go to the house next week.</p>
