Talked about how all of Nampa Schools now have Vape detectors in all bathrooms. Also assigned class group curriculum "To good 4 Drugs"</p> <p>Tara: Having SRO Dave Gomez make educational videos, and getting him to go to communities for lunch and learns.</p> <p>Waiting for updates to hear about any next round of funding through the PFS grant. The PFS grant has provided funding to support TIP (trauma informed program) expanding into region 3 to help after a crisis. TIP brings therapy dogs, trained counselors, etc. We have PFS funds available to support projects until the end of May</p> <p>Linda – Discussed the Reentry/ Reaction Team, trouble shooting some of the problems with IDJC youth that cross over with the Department of Health and Welfare for re-entry.</p> <p>Chad – talked about the new regulations and threat assessment.</p> <p>Dahlia – Crisis Intervention Conference with Ellis Amdur and the Idaho Crisis training is Feb. 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. First day is on line and second day is in person. Email sent to board members on 1/27 with information about the convention. She discussed the Vaping issues and kids with mental issues in schools and the best way to help and make things happen..</p>	All Members
