This will be for truancy courses and other courses that are not covered by SUDs funding. Dixie made a second. Council approved the motion for up to \$1,500.00 for the courses.</p>	
5.	IDJC Liaison Update	<p>LaMark Judkins was hired as new District Liaison (DL) for District 3. LaMark brings 25 years of experience in the Department of Juvenile Corrections, having served in various roles including working with juveniles and as a training coordinator.</p> <p>The shelter care contract for status offenders will not continue into FY 2026. The previous payment methond did not meet federal grant standards. The group is open to alternative solutions to prevent status offenders from entering detentions.</p> <p>Law Enforcement visits are scheduled to begin at the end of August and will run through September. A question was raised regarding any new Law Enforcement sites in District 5. Carol Johnson reported that the Gooding County Sheriff's Office now has a substation in Hagerman. Jeff Miller will follow up on this and nortify the Planning and Compliance team.</p> <p>Company called 3rd Millennium is an organization that provides online courses for individuals involved in the justice system.
