Agenda:

1. Action Item: Approve February 12, 2025 Meeting Minutes
 - a. Meeting minutes approval was tabled to the next Council meeting. There are connectivity issues with the Council portal. Jessica will investigate with IT.
2. Discussion Item: Updates on Current Projects
 - a. IBHC
 - i. There is a data team kickoff meeting on May 2, 2025 at 10am to discuss data points and responsibility for pulling data.
 - ii. Agencies will review civil commitment and competency restoration flow charts to identify data points within the Court and DHW systems. Agencies will assign responsibility for collecting and disseminating the data to SCO.
 - iii. Leadership is asked to join briefly, via Webex or in-person, to kickoff the meeting and do not need to stay for the duration unless they wish.
 - b. IDVR as an Intervention
 - i. All data has been received, worked with Jeff to clean data.
 - ii. Team is analyzing data using tools in the new AWS standard cloud. This allows for use of more tools for analytics and visualizations.
 - iii. John Iasonides addressed that while GovCloud was secure, the new cloud offers even greater security.
 - c. Domestic Violence and Final Adjudication
 - i. The SCO team is waiting for fingerprints to be processed by ISP and the FBI.
 - ii. When approved, they will have authority to access to criminal history data and are working with ISP.
 - d. Supervision and Law Enforcement Contact Prior to Violation
 - i. SCO is waiting for ISP to provide the executed MOU.
 - ii. Finger printing was complete and waiting on background checks to come back.
 - iii. ISP assures that once background checks are done, the MOU will be executed.

3. Discussion Item: Additional Council Business
 - a. Automation Requests
 - i. Monty is interested in automating child welfare data sharing within the Insight environment.
 - ii. Jessica is going to follow up offline and schedule a meeting with the relevant DHW team.
 - b. MOU and Cloud Updates
 - i. Sarah has some concern over the upcoming cloud storage changes and the existing MOU with the Courts.
 - ii. Jessica will review the agreements to confirm the next steps, if necessary.
