1. Action Item: Approve February 12, 2025, Meeting Minutes
  - a. Bree Derrick motioned to approve February 12, 2025, meeting minutes. Matt Smith seconded. Motion carries and minutes are approved.
2. Discussion Item: Updates on Current Projects

Jessica Bilbao gave an update on the status of each project.

  - a. IBHC Civil Commitments & Competency Restoration
    - i. Work has been delayed due to the government cloud to standard cloud migration. Two data meetings were held over the summer and agencies are working on pulling their data to transfer to Insight. SCO hopes to begin working on the project soon.
  - b. IBHC Prevention Subcommittee
    - i. Insight may be asked to assist the IBHC Prevention Subcommittee in some of their action items. There is no formal request currently.
  - c. IDVR as an Intervention
    - i. Work has been delayed due to the government cloud to standard cloud migration. SCO hopes to begin working on the project soon. This project is a priority when the migration is complete.
  - d. Domestic Violence and Final Adjudication

- i. Work has been delayed due to the government cloud to standard cloud migration. SCO hopes to begin working on the project soon. This project is a priority when the migration is complete.
  - e. Community Gap Analysis 2026
    - i. Bree Derrick indicated Insight will complete the project this year. Jessica Bilbao will coordinate with IDOC & DHW to gather the necessary data. This project will be a priority when the migration is complete and is due to the Legislature no later than January 15, 2026.
  - f. Law Enforcement Contact Prior to Violation
    - i. This project has been on the backburner. Jessica Bilbao will circle back with the Sheriff's Association regarding this year's data. The Council discussed the 4<sup>th</sup> Amendment recent legislative change that will impact individuals on misdemeanor probation.
