Formula Funding Discussion/ Presentation	Angela Lamb, Serve Idaho	<p>Angela gave a recap of the recommendations of the Program Committee. None of the competitive applications were granted. Total requested FY25 is \$6,251,648. Formula available is \$1,707,660. Serve Idaho still has access to \$800,000 in funding with no formal guidance on how to spend the money from the federal government. Seventy percent of programs were terminated. None of the competitive applicants were funded. Programs were asked to share their bare minimal funding needs. The Program Committee decided: no new programs, no institution has more than one program, no national directs, and apply to use the unexpected funds from terminated grants for supplemental funding and/or waitlisted programs. Motion to approve the Program Committee recommendations (Scenario A with the dollar amounts in discretion. Scenario B is if the \$800,000 is not available.) made by Mat. Seconded by Kimber. Farhana abstains. Motion passes.</p>
