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	<p>Shannon inquired if the JJC6 would like to have IDJC staff come in for a presentation on the money. The council members feel satisfied with their current understanding and don't need IDJC support. Stace commented that if there were large scale changes to fund streams, we could consider asking IDJC staff for assistance. The Federal gov shutdown is no longer actively impacting IDJC.</p> <p>The Village sent a story back to the council about how funding made a difference to the program participants.</p>	
<p>Action Item: Council recruiting/guest involvement</p>	<p>Review communication on council efforts throughout Region 6.</p> <p>Shaefer Call presented his resume, letter of interest, and spoke to how he would like to join the council to help be a youth voice from Bannock county.</p>	<p>All Members</p>
<p>Discussion: 3 Year Plan Work</p>	<p>Review progress with assigned tasks.</p> <p>TBRI (Trust Based Relation Intervention) Training Opportunity (Shannon/Stace/Racheal)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - High County Behavioral Health – have a TBRI training option listed on their website but they have not been responsive to outreach. - Roxanne Prince – Racheal's Contact that works at NNU, judge call thinks this will be very beneficial. She is still certified to train. Racheal will help establish a relationship with Roxanne to see what collaboration would look like. The timeline could be to try and host the training in about 6 months. - Details for the training: There are 6 basic session from what Racheal remembers. Judge Call believes it could be beneficial for SROs/POs. Might be beneficial to review more about the training at the next council meeting. It was discussed that training for rural areas would be challenging. Trevyn suggested that it would likely be that departments send a few staff to the training that would then report back. <p>Crisis Resources/Educational Sessions (Shannon/Stace)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Due to the workload that Matt Hardin is under at Magellan, seeking other individuals to provide presentations. These individuals could be the two social workers stationed in Pocatello to come to the JJC meeting to discuss what they are doing. There has been positive feedback to having the MRT's from Magellan available as a resource. <p>DSO Review Training (Stace, Judge Call, Matt)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Working with Judges for scheduling - Jason Dye was offering March, May - When is the best time for the judges (they are prioritized), March 20th - Judge Call can assist with securing a location - The training will likely take 2ish hours 	<p>All Members</p>



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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Keeping the training specific to Judges (we could make the offer to District 6) but it will likely be a smaller group - It would be great to share the information with neighboring councils - Stace reached out to HQ today and they will bring in any new statutes or educational information into the training to help update the groups knowledge of new rules. For example how the human trafficking screener has to be utilized.
