Idaho Technology Authority (ITA) Regular Meeting

1. Welcome and Introductions—Presented by Alberto Gonzalez, Chair

ACTION ITEM(S)

2. Approval of Draft Minutes—March 28, 2024 Regular Meeting

Committee Action: Dave Tolman made a motion to approve the March 28, 2024 minutes. Faith Knowlton seconded. No discussion. Motion passed.

3. NEW ITA Policy P1015 – Information Technology Policies, Standards, and Guidelines Development – Presented by Kristin Bartz, ITS

Discussion: This is a new policy to define the process of developing or modifying policies, standards, and guidelines (“Documents”) for ITA and its subcommittees.

Chairman Gonzalez spoke in support of documenting the existing process.

Committee Action: Ms. Knowlton made a motion to approve P1015. Mr. Tolman seconded this motion. No further discussion. Motion approved.

4. ITA Policy P1050 – Internet Use and Controls – Presented by Jennifer Dvorak, ITLC Chair

Discussion: This is a modification to an existing policy, including title, reformatting, and changes to section 11.

Committee Action: Ms. Knowlton moved to approved P1050 as presented. Mr. Tolman seconded. No further discussion. Motion approved.

5. ITA Policy P1060 – State Issued IT Devices – Presented by Jennifer Dvorak, ITLC Chair

Discussion: This is a modification to an existing policy, including title, and changes to section 2, 4, 5, and 9.

Discussion about consequences of not returning devices and assets belonging to agencies.

Mr. Tolman suggested the modification in section 9 from “will be” to “shall”.

Committee Action: Mr. Tolman moved to approve P1060 with modification in section 9 from “will be” to “shall”. Scott Smith seconded. Motion approved.

6. ITA Policy P1090 – Cloud Services—Presented by Elizabeth Knox, ITS

Discussion: this is a combination of P1080 and P4120. The new combined policy provides one place to refer to for cloud related policy. Chairman Gonzalez asked how ITS can enforce or assist with data classification. Brian Reed, ITS, commented that ITS has the ability to aid agencies, but agencies need to be able to classify themselves.

Mr. Smith questioned how this policy applies to contractor cloud platforms. Ms. Knox advised that changes would need to be made to the policy.

Committee Action: P1090 is going back to the committee for further review.

7. 2024 Idaho Digital Government Summit—Presented by Alberto Gonzalez, Chair

Discussion: Chairman Gonzalez informed members that invites for the 2024 Idaho Digital Government Summit have been sent out and to follow up with him if anyone would like to attend but did not receive an invitation.
