

Water District 11F
Annual Water Meeting
February 25, 2026



The meeting came to order at 7 pm February 25, 2026, at the Geneva LDS church building. The first item of business was to elect a meeting chairman and meeting secretary. The motion was made for Devin B. to act as meeting chair by Richard L. 2nd by Kevin W., motion passed. The motion was made for James T to act as meeting secretary by Gene B. and second by Eric T. The motion passed.

James was asked to read the minutes from the 2025 meeting. The motion was made to accept the minutes as read by Eric T and 2nd by Derek B. The motion passed.

Jose Pachero is here from the Preston office. He mentioned the adjudication is moving forward. The directors report should be out by dec 31, 2026 and start reviews in 2027.

James was asked to give the treasurers report. The actual revenue received was \$7,733.73 and actual expenses were \$6,566.40. There was one 2024 assessment received in January of 2025 for \$813.00. The district bank account at Zions bank stands at \$24,840.81 with one outstanding check as of end 2025. It was asked why the budgeted amount for payroll taxes was lower than the actual. That is because the actual amount holds both half of the tax from the district and the employees.

Joel gave the water master report. He mentioned that less water was delivered in 2025. It made the cost of water \$1.01 per 24 second feet. He mentioned that the state water department came down and measured at the diversions to see if the measuring devices were reading right. The outlook for the valley and water in 2026 is not looking promising. The snow is melting fast. Rodney B. asked about the hall ditch head gate. Devin stated the permit finally came and contractor was held up last fall. The work will be completed this summer/fall. It was asked if the hall ditch was to be shut off if the water was called for. The answer is yes. It was stated that the beaver might be stopping the water from flowing down the Thomas Fork. The hall ditch project was talked about in the 2025 meeting. It was not completed during that year. The water needs to be shut off in 2026 if the water is called for.

The proposed budget is \$6,724.93 for revenue and expenses. It will be passed in the vote on the resolutions. The resolutions for 2026 have two corrections. The years for the water master and treasurer will be changed to 2027. The motion was made by Rodney B. and 2nd by Ken R. the motion was passed to accept the resolutions with the corrections.

Other district business. It was asked if everyone had a measuring device at their diversions. There was a debate over if the device is not working the water cannot be called for. The water master should not turn on water if the devices are not working.

The motion was made by Richard to close the meeting and 2nd by Eric T. The motion passed. Meeting closed.

Resolutions

Be it resolved, The proposed budget for water year 2026 be set at \$6,724.93

Be it resolved, That Joel Teuscher be elected Water Master of water district 11F for 2026 water year, starting now and ending February 25, 2027.

Be it Resolved, That James Teuscher be elected Secretary/Treasurer of the Water District 11F for the water year 2026 starting now and ending on February 25, 2027.

Be it Resolved, That the following water users are on the advisory board: Chris Esterholdt, Richard Loertscher, Derek Boehme.

Devin Boehme to be re-elected to another term ending in 2029.

Rodney Boehme to be re-elected to another term ending in 2029.

Be it Resolved, That the Water Master shall not deliver water to a person or entity until the assessment amount is paid or arrangements have been made with the Water Master.

Be it Resolved, It is the responsibility of the ditch company, canal company or individual water user to keep the metering devices repaired and working along with keeping the area clean and weed free.

Be it Resolved, That the Water Master shall have access to control structures, measuring devices and make reasonable entry on lands within the water district.

Be it Resolved, The assessment amount shown in the adopted budget shall constitute a final determination of the amount due for that year. (per Idaho code 42-612).

Be it Resolved, The Water master shall prepare assessments for the current year budget after the water users present at the annual meeting have formally adopted the budget. Then the treasurer shall mail out assessments that will be due **April 15, 2026**.

Be it Resolved, The Annual meeting of Water District 11F shall be held the last Wednesday or Thursday of February each year.
