5. Discussion Item: OIP Monitoring

Review and discuss 2026 monitoring of approved programs

Committee Identified seven potential programs for monitoring in 2026. Amber, Mark, and Ursula offered to assist with any monitoring being conducted in their area.

6. Discussion Item: Open Committee Seats

Committee discussed potential candidates to fill empty seats. The number of committee members has decreased in the last year and additional members are needed for more robust discussion and to help ensure a quorum is present to conduct committee business during meetings. Amber stressed regional representation and recommended including a victim witness coordinator and prosecutor be considered for the open seats.

7. Discussion Item: Committee Member's Reports

Amber Moe – mentioned the Idaho Safety and Resilience Conference will be virtual this year and encouraged members to think about potential presenters. The conference call for proposals is out right now with proposals due this week. She would like to include at least a couple of sessions that would benefit OIP providers. Amber also mentioned that she will be presenting at the next Domestic Violence Advisory Team meeting to share information about the OIP Committee, the Minimum Standards, the approval process for intervention providers, telecommunications approval process and requirements, and the pilot project underway with Trivium Life Services.

Ursula Warden – would like to have a session for DV Evaluators at the Safety and Resilience Conference to discuss how providers can identify deception from offenders, behavior cues, language cues, etc. Suggested session presenters could include mental health professionals who work with offenders and also law enforcement.
