NEWS RELEASE: Eastern Idaho Electric Utility Submits Application Seeking Approval of Proposed Asset Transfer

BOISE (June 16, 2026) – The Idaho Public Utilities Commission has scheduled a hearing and set a written comments deadline for an application submitted by Rocky Mountain Power to transfer a customer’s electric service and some infrastructure to the city of Idaho Falls.

Approval of asset transfer agreements requires that the acquiring utility compensates the serving utility for lost revenues and the distribution infrastructure used to provide service to the customer. Distribution infrastructure can include poles, wires, crossarms, insulators and cables.

The Commission will hold a telephonic hearing to take testimony for the record on the proposed transfer. The hearing will be held on Tuesday, July 14, 2026. It will begin at 11:00 a.m. (MDT) and conclude at 11:30 a.m. or after all testimony has been taken, whichever comes first. Written comments are being accepted through July 10, 2026. Comments must be filed through the Commission’s website or by email unless computer access is not available. To submit comments through the website, visit puc.idaho.gov and click on the “Case Comment Form” link on the upper left side of the page.
