Discussion: Informative Presentation by Roxanne Printz	Discussion regarding what resources that Roxanne has to offer to those interested in TBRI training. Roxanne offered information on how the TBRI training could be a good way to follow up for the cross-over youth model. Gina offered a perspective of how her organization would benefit as they work with children who have complex backgrounds that involve trauma "ACE's". She expressed that this would be a beneficial way to explore working with the children who have these complex backgrounds. Roxanne mentioned that the training has an impact at an individual level and at system levels. Racheal added that she see's this type of information is a great way to expand just being aware of trauma "ACE's" and move into working with these youth. Roanne mentioned that the Coeur d'Alene school district engaged in using the TBRI model. It is still working in their systems today.
