3. Discussion Item: Updates on Current Projects

Jessica Bilbao gave an update on each project.

- a. IBHC Civil Commitments & Competency Restoration
 - i. Courts plan to transfer the data very soon. Data architects plan to review the data as soon as it is received. Jessica will loop in with the other data partners to fill gaps in data if needed.
- b. IBHC Prevention Subcommittee
 - i. There have been no updates for Insight related to this project.
- c. IDVR as an Intervention
 - i. Data is prepped and components have been migrated.
 - ii. Jessica plans to have the report completed and to the Council for review in January 2026.

- d. Domestic Violence and Final Adjudication
 - i. ISP will conduct a pre-audit of Insight prior to data transfer. Insight expects to begin working on this project in early 2026.
- e. Law Enforcement Contact Prior to Violation
 - i. Insight is working on getting this year's data transfer from the Sheriff's Association/Equifax.
 - ii. Insight expects to begin working on this project in early 2026.
- f. Community Gap Analysis 2026
 - i. There are delays getting the data from Magellan. Monty Prow will escalate.

- a. Automatic data transfer
 - i. Monty Prow and Jessica will connect offline to set up a time for each agency's IT teams to connect.
