Call to Order	The meeting was called to order by council chair at 4:00pm	Shannon Fox
Discussion: Community Discussion on the Needs for Bear Lake County	Discussion regarding what resources the community has, needs, or wants to explore. Tracie and Trevyn provided background on challenges that Cameron (local high school counselor) has been facing within the walls of the schools. There is a highlighted desire for controlled substance recognition by educators. Trevyn expressed that mental health is a large priority as the community experienced 3 suicides within the last month. Trevyn shared his connection to resources to help address mental health concerns. Community resources have been deployed, 988 information is being offered, safety plan notebooks are being circulated as well as sending out materials for schools. Cameron is wanting an educational resource that could do a training during the teacher workday that is district wide. There was a review of options including Tall Call and local training resources (one of the past IJJA presenters). The council discussed what the cost/benefits were for different approaches to securing a speaker. Shannon, Trevyn, Stace, and Tracie will work to secure a speaker. Dedra also offered to also	All Members and guests present



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	assist with a speaker resource that she had in mind. The likely dates of this meeting would be the week of August 17th. Libby also mentioned that a Utah resource, CAPSA, could be a resource as well. This may include putting together an MDT for Franklin county as well as meeting with the Bear Lake school district. Libby would also be involved via providing a mandated reporter training. The prosecutors office offered that they have not been seeing drugs or controlled substance issues at their office. They also feel the mental health side of the community issues is more pressing, along with safety and security in the home, and that substance use is often an indicator of other challenges. There was a review on the impact of Malena mentioned that her organization can offer resources at no cost through the child advocacy center that could be offered at schools in a variety of formats. Stace highlighted that D6 treatment and MK Place out of Pocatello can provide substance abuse counseling resources to the other counties. Physical space is not as big of a challenge as lack of providers. Todd mentioned that ISU counseling department and R6 DJC and him are working to secure funding for a doctorate level counselor 10hrs a week and this individual will supervise other counselors. Todd has a list of providers that provide tele-health. AmeriCorps may also be expanded this upcoming year back to 900hrs of service versus 300hrs. Stace reviewed reports that he prepares for each of the counties on an annual basis. Shannon commented that the reports across D6 reflect that kiddos 14-16 are getting in trouble so if we move upstream, what resources do these children need when they are younger for a preventative approach. Stace can send these reports to anyone who would like them.
