Work on Jeff D IAP Objective B.3.e.ii has completed its initial phase, confirming through data and exploration that the Juvenile Justice and Developmental Disability (JJ/DD) population is systemically underserved. However, the second phase focused on developing mitigation strategies is currently paused and is likely to move forward in Winter SFY27. This delay is due to resources remaining heavily diverted toward deliverables previously agreed upon and prioritized through mediation. Furthermore, additional new deliverables are now moving into mediation, which will continue to impact resource capacity moving forward. 5/4/26, In Progress. The stakeholder meeting originally planned to address DD/SED and SED/complex youth within Juvenile Detention and IDJC custody was deferred due to persistent scheduling conflicts and the subsequent diversion of resources toward other prioritized implementation deliverables. DHW anticipates moving forward with mitigation strategy planning this fall. This work will begin internally with DHW staff and relevant defendant parties to develop a foundational framework. Once this internal planning is complete, the Department will engage stakeholders to receive feedback and further vet the strategies by gaining support from youth and families with lived experience. Specific dates remain TBD based on resource allocation. 1/21/26, In Progress. The IAP deliverable updates will be included in DHW implementation updates. The DD/SED Juvenile Justice workgroup has been paused to prioritize the IWG's work on Jeff D IAP Objective B.3.e. ii. A formal notice of

				this pause was sent to stakeholders on December 4, 2025. CMH is currently coordinating a follow-up meeting with stakeholders to ensure these populations (DD/SED youth and SED/complex youth) served in Juvenile Detention Centers and youth served in IDJC custody are accurately represented in the IAP deliverable. While a Doodle poll was provided, CMH is working through persistent scheduling conflicts to ensure this conversation occurs. Stakeholders will be re-engaged through IGT subcommittees once the second phase of the IAP deliverable occurs. The second phase includes developing mitigation plans for engaging the systemically underserved populations identified. There is no definitive timeline for this phase due to resources currently diverted to deliverables agreed upon and prioritized through mediation.

Updates from DHW: Completed. Rather than an ICC/Wraparound subcommittee, ongoing conversations and collaboration are regularly occurring between IDHW, Magellan, and Class Counsel. These efforts are designed to ensure youth receive timely access to ICC, that services provided are intensive and meaningful, and that families experience coordinated, team-based support for as long as clinically appropriate. Furthermore, DHW and Class Counsel are collaboratively finalizing ICC descriptions in the Services and Supports Crosswalk to guide MCO service delivery. Updates will be provided as appropriate to the IGT strategic planning and in relation to the implementation updates. 1/26/26, In Progress. Currently discussed in IWG to determine where the barriers are. Once identified, this will be brought back to the IGT Executive Committee and the IGT regarding a status report and potential recommendation.
